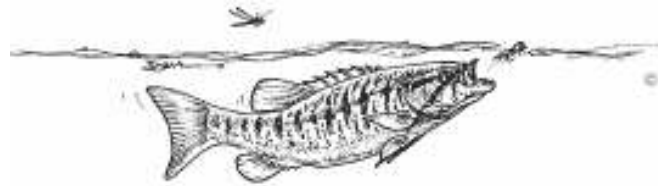
Environmental Education Program



The Catskill Fly Fishing Center & Museum will be conducting a series of summer environmental education weekends for children during the month of July at our facilities located along the Willowemoc Creek in Livingston Manor, New York. This is a unique opportunity for children ages 8-14 to explore the environment and develop conservation awareness and angling skills. The program features a hands-on approach to learning in an informal setting limited to 20 participants each weekend.
