

Dear Fly Fishing Community Vendors,

It is my pleasure to invite you to participate in the CFFCM 2008 Summerfest and Anglers Market Sunday, August 10, 2008 and The Arts of the Angler Show in Danbury, CT November 15 & 16, 2008. Enclosed, please find contracts and information on each.

As you know Summerfest and Anglers Market is the longest running summer event, for fly fishing and outdoor sporting collectible enthusiasts, at the CFFCM. Over the years, this event has been held on the last Saturday in August or the Saturday of Labor Day Weekend. After last year's event, it was determined to make another date change and combine it with our successful Annual Jubilee Day on Sunday, August 10. This combination will make it a Super Sunday in the Catskills. It is our belief that combining it with Jubilee Day will greatly increase attendance to our property and for vendors.

Jubilee Day is a Sullivan County celebration and summer fun day for families. It is held on the Museum side of the property, just the other side of the stairs. Local civic organizations, crafters, farm produce suppliers, and other community groups provide family events and activities. In addition, we have live fiddle music, games for kids, a fishing derby at the pond, The Great Willowemoc Fish Race, chicken BBQ and even pony rides and a petting zoo. Combined with Summerfest and Anglers Market, it will definitely be a Super Sunday.

Participating exhibitors may choose to be located under the Pavilion or in the Open Field. Please note that space in the Pavilion is limited and available on a first-come first serve basis.

Pavilion - six-foot table space (vendor provides tables & chairs). **Open Field** - allows for setup of larger displays and/or vehicles.

Please complete and return your exhibitor registration to the CFFCM postmarked by July 15, 2008 in order to qualify for the Early Bird reduced rate of \$40 for CFFCM members and \$50 for non-members. (The rate increases to \$50 and \$60 respectively on July 16.) Upon receipt of your Registration Form and payment, we will send a written confirmation of your space assignment. Be sure to note your location preference – Pavilion or Open Field – on the registration form.

The Arts of the Angler Show: The 2007 Arts of the Angler Show was deemed a major success for the first CFFCM off site event, held at the Ethan Allen Inn in Danbury CT. **NOTE:** This year the Show will be held at the **Danbury Sheraton on November 15 & 16**. This weekend will follow the Lang's Auction and precede the International Fly Tying Symposium in Somerset. Promotion has already started on this year's show and we are looking forward to a noticeable growth. For those of you familiar with previous *Arts of the Angler Shows* held at the Sheraton will remember the large open foyer for collectibles and larger ballroom for fly tying and full size booths. We have many new programs and activities planned. I welcome your input.

Summerfest and the Anglers' Market is a popular end of the season event and we anticipate a large crowd. The Arts of the Angler show will once again be a unique event designed to satisfy the most discriminating fly fisher.
