- 31 **1900 Forest & Game Commission of NY Report**. Contains many black and white photos and colored prints. Several Dentons included (please note in this issue there were no trout or salmon). Back inside hinge is broken. Otherwise, this book is in very good condition.
- 32 **Six flies tyed by the late Matty Vinciguerra** with signature card. Includes 2 Salty Beady Eyes, Golden Shirner, Black Nose Dace, Catskill Chub and Blue Barred Runner. Matty was a great photographer who worked with Eric Leiser, Kenneth Bay and many other authors. His flies are considered some of the most innovative and his early work with epoxies in the 80's were the prototypes of many patterns today. Elegant framing overall size 15" x 16".

- 34 **Eric Leiser Black Angus dome with Leiser signature pin**. This is one of Eric's most recognized patterns.

3/4 leather binding with gilt cloth borders, gilt spine lettering, raised bands, stamped  
compartments. Massive, beautiful, well-preserved reference for fly fishing from the 1940s.  
Includes a loose envelope containing six color-lithographed plates illustrating various flies. Also  
contains numerous illustrations -- some color, others in black and white -- throughout the text. In  
VG+ to near fine, clean, tight, and sound condition. Book measures c. 7" W x 9 1/2"
- 36 **Thaddeus Norris The American Angler's Book: Embracing the Natural History of  
Sporting Fish and the Art of Taking Them**, E. H. Butler, Philadelphia, 1865. Hardcover. In  
fine condition. No Dust Jacket. 80 Wood Engravings (illustrator). Scarce. 8vo. Variant of new  
edition w/ supplement, containing descriptions of salmon rivers, inland trout fishing, etc. xxiii,  
(24)-701pp. Green blind-panelled publisher's cloth with their monogram embossed on both  
covers, gilt bright on spine, teg, beveled boards. This appears to be a scarce variant of the  
second edition, usually referred to as the "Memorial Edition", however, this copy retains the  
Butler imprint on the t.p. (which makes no mention of this being the Memorial Edition), but is  
dated 1865. Stamped on the lower spine in gilt is "Porter & Coates".
- 37 **Trout Flies by Richard Salmon**. New York: Sportsman's Edge Press, 1975. Reproduced from  
the author's elegant calligraphic manuscript and inscribed on colophon, " First edition, No.335 of  
589 numbered and signed copies. 8vo. With drawings by the author and 12 page containing  
numerous mounted specimens of feathers, fur, and other fly-tying components. Original dark  
green rexine, gilt, very fine in fine matching slipcase. Please note: only 12 of the 44 patterns  
included in this book have materials tipped in. This book was never completed.
- 38 **Paul Ptalis tied African Gray** full feather salmon fly. Paul Ptalis was considered one of the  
finest classic and contemporary salmon fly tyers of his time. This original pattern, tied by Paul  
was used for the cover and included in his one book, "Century End". Unmounted. A signed copy  
of his book (paperback is included). Other photos follow. (Paul Ptalis 1947-2008)

Superb colour photographs throughout. Text in Japanese and English. Full black velvet binding.  
Fine in slipcase. Signed by the author. Introductions by James Hardy and Alan Bramley. Over  
500 full-colour photographs depicting salmon flies. 15"x11", full black velvet, chromatic fore-  
edge, pictorial slipcase, original cardboard box. "...a fly dresser is an artist, just as much as a  
sculptor or painter." In this book are shown, by excellent photography some of the classic salmon  
flies of bygone days in all their beauty - truly a work of art.
- 40 **Bamboo Rod, New. Bob Taylor custom 7' 6" 5/6 weight, 4 piece**, two tip (one to  
follow directly from Bob), model 76-5/6W-377. Bob's rods are one of the most highly desired  
hand crafted fly rods in the world today. He is recognized as one of the finest makers ever to  
come out of the Leonard rod shop and has over 30 years of fine tuning and maintaining his high  
standards in the craft. They don't get much better than this rod. It is super sweet and unique in  
every way. You might never see another Taylor rod like this ever come your way.
- 41 **Royal Lee Full Dress Salmon Fly** Tied by Jim Bashline for presentation to Lee Wulff on March  
11, 1983 at the Frauncis Tavern, NYC. In lovely wooden box w/copper engraved.

- 42 **The Toy Fly** designed and tyed by Mike Radencich. Mounted in 11 x 13" custom frame. From the Paul Ptalis collection.
- 43 **Treatise Flies tyed by Marc Tozi**, March 30, 1992. Mounted and framed by Don Leyden, DonMar Studios. All flies were constructed in the original descriptions. Hooks were hand made, materials dyed, and leads hand braided by Tozie.
- 44 **Paul Schmookler variation of the Double Leopard** in signature deep tray mount.
- 45 **Per Brandin 834-2 df HB, 3.25 oz. marked 2/10**. This rod is an 8'3" dry fly taper for #4 line in two pieces and six strip semi-hollow construction. This is a brand new rod just out of the shop from my current production of this model. It has flamed cane, translucent cinnamon wraps, a low bridge agate stripper, matte 'quiet' finish (rubbed varnish) and a n/s cap & band over mahogany reel seat. Comes with ferrule plug, original bag and labeled tube as well as outer tube bag.

- 57 **Mead Schaeffer colored lithograph *Fly Fishing Virtuoso***; with three 29-cent USA fly fishing stamps, uncancelled, including Muddler Minnow, Royal Wulff, and Jock Scott, all in plastic sleeves, framed in a wood frame, measuring 22.75" x 18.5" overall.
- 58 **Life cycle mount of eight flies**, unknown tyer.

- 59 **Two Winslow Homer prints;** *Castin*, 1897 and issued by the American Museum of Fly Fishing in collaboration with The Peabody Museum of Natural History and Yale University, New Haven, CT, Dec 1992 through April 1993. 18" X24" Shrink-wrapped on a foamcore board. Second is a 1900 print by Homer, exquisite print quality in double matted frame.
- 60 **Vintage 'cheesecake' fishing pin-up poster** print by Earl Moran up by one of America's finest 'girlie' illustrators. 21" x 29" in gilt wood simple frame. Slight moisture ripple across bottom but unnoticeable. Noted for his calendar work with Brown & Bigelow from 1932-1955. This one says "*they always take my bait, hook, line and sinker*"
- 61 **Scientific Angler 2 piece 9'4' 9W System G, Metal Spigot Ferrules**
- 62 **Fisher 4 piece g-T40 9' 5/6 W Early Brown Graphite Vintage Rod**
- 63 **Shore Decoys Lot**, vintage. 5 old ones.

It has a hammer (eliptica) grip, bakelite reel seat and an uncompromised varnish finish. Handle is somewhat soiled from use but the rod is in overall excellent condition.
- 77 **Six Reels with Silk Fly Line.** Six (6) different used reels in various conditions each containing a silk fly line that can be re instituted.
