Prizes will be awarded for first fish, most fish, largest fish and smallest fish. Kids are to bring their own tackle and favorite baits. At 1:30 The Great Willowemoc Fish Race will be held and immediately after will follow with the Jubilee Day Cake. The CFFCM will once again celebrate birthday and anniversary milestones ending in a 0 or 5. Everyone is welcome and cake will be provided at no charge. . This is a fine day to share your celebration with your family and community.
