This award was created by Poul Jorgensen to recognize a fly tyer who makes a major impact on fly tying today and not the past. Patlen is considered America's Ambassador to fly tying. His personal appearances and demonstrations world wide keeps an energy, edginess, and often the most unorthodox techniques to the craft of fly tying to the delight of everyone. The actual award is a medallion created by one of the world's finest medal sculptors, Bud Wertheim, and bears the likeness of Poul.
