This is the 23rd consecutive year of educational and recreational activities offered to youngsters at the Center. The programs are designed to instill an appreciation for the general environment and more specifically, the water environment. The "hands on" approach to learning in a natural setting makes the learning fun!

Education instructors, Pete and Caren Jacques will provide a complete curriculum including: in-stream ecology, entomology, freshwater biology, and the environmental issues resulting from acid rain, as well as the fundamentals of the sport of fly-fishing.
